

Yellowstone Gear List

ITEM	# REQUIRED	DESCRIPTIONS
Sleeping Bag w/compression sack	1	Fiber-fill to 20 degrees/ no down or cotton. Should pack easily. Must be able to fit in a compression sack measuring 10x10x20 inches.
Hiking Boots	1 pair	An outdoor store can help you choose these. The boots should be sized with hiking socks. Should be broken in before camp. Wear them for an hour or more a day for a week or so before camp to prevent blisters and sore feet at camp.
Sport Sandals with backstrap	1 pair	For water play and showering etc.(like Texas)
Socks	4 pairs	Wool or synthetic hiking socks- NO COTTON May choose to get liner socks, too (thin)
Rain Jacket -breathable	1	Make sure it is appropriate coverage for heavy rain.
Set of Town Clothes	1	Long pants and shirt
T-shirts - synthetic	2	Sports or hiking shirts that dry quickly
Shorts	2	Shorts with liners are great to hike in. Quick dry nylon shorts are recommended.
Pants	3	2 Nylon hiking pants - comfortable and dry easily 1 pr. Fleece pants (like synthetic sweats)
Underwear	4	Polyester better than cotton
Jacket	1	Heavy fleece or synthetic fill (warm!)
Pack Towel	1	Fleece chamois – find in auto dept. or hiking store
Travel Toothbrush and toothpaste	1	
Sunglasses	1	Good UV protection; strap recommended
Travel Shampoo, soap, brush		
Water bottle	2	Large size-32oz (we suggest Nalgene brand)
Headlamp or Flashlight & Batteries	1	Lightweight
Long underwear	1 bottom, 2 tops	Medium weight, synthetic polyester- NO COTTON
Hat and gloves	1	Wool or fleece
Bandana	1-2	
Sleeping Pad	1	Foam or inflatable (small backpacking kind)
Backpack	1	It must fit all gear on this list, plus some group food and gear. Please make sure this pack is an appropriate size for your camper. (4000 Cubic inches is perfect capacity) Use this as your only luggage; pack in a lightweight duffle bag for protection on the plane.

Spending money	\$20-\$30	Only needed for souvenirs and plane food
Book or writing material	1	Caution: may be damaged on trip
Camera, Watch, Binoculars	1	Avoid expensive ones; might be damaged Waterproof
